

- Revenue model is selling once
- No take-back
- Centralised production optimised for 1-way materials flow
- Use fast fashion to encourage replacement

Dealers

- Sell once
- No take-back capability

Designers & Contractors

 Unable to source sustainable options or remanufacture used items

Demolition Contractor

- No clarity on materials or their recyclability
- No buyers for used products





- 1. Disposal activities/contracts disconnected from supply contracts
- 2. Frameworks/panels entrench incumbents for 4 years
- 3. \$/unit focus, encouraging low-quality short-life products made in low wage countries with no social or environmental concern
